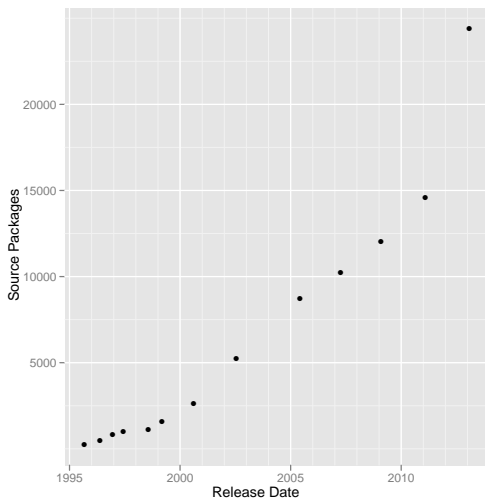

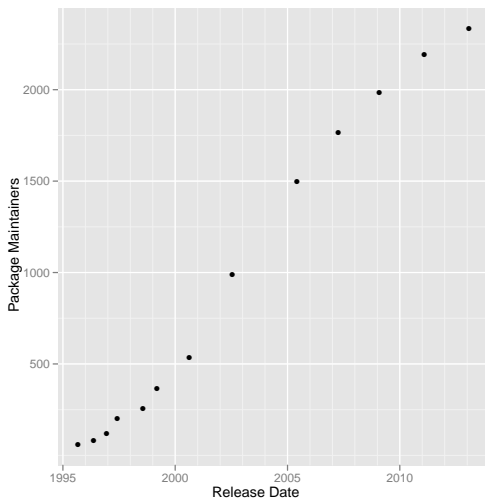

- Documentation

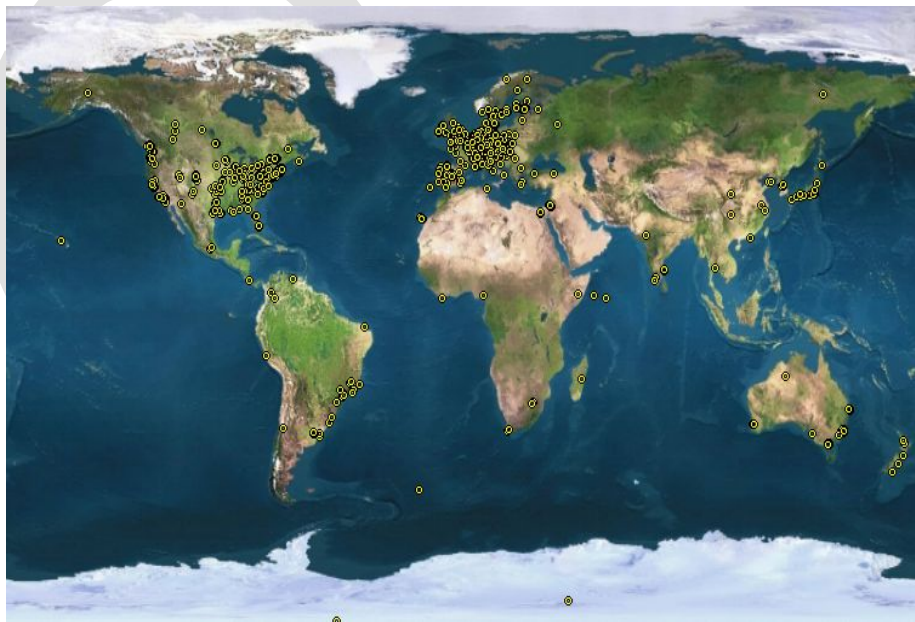


Developers

Where are Debian Developers?



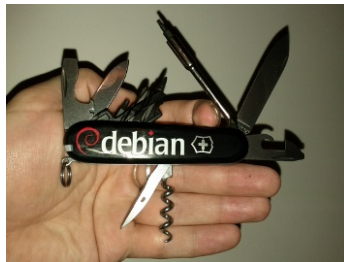
Debian Project Leader

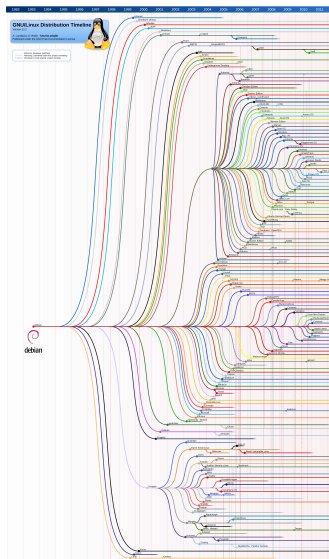

Binary Package: deb

- Actual work done by dpkg-buildpackage
- Calls debian/rules binary
- Generates changes, debian packages
- Physically an ar archive with three members; see deb(5) for more details
 - ▶ debian-binary
 - ▶ control.tar.gz
 - ▶ data.tar (optionally compressed)

Utilities

- debhelper

Uploading Packages

- Upload source package and binary
- Signed with DD (or DM) GPG Key
- Using debsign and dput
- Suite Target
- Delay Queue

Building for other architectures

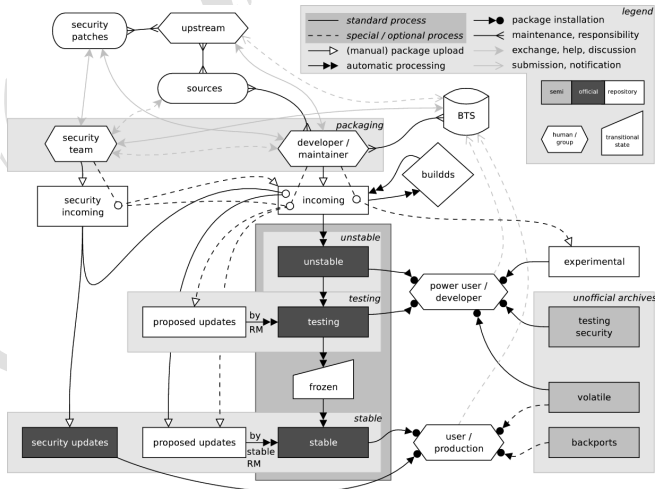
- wanna-build (database of packages to build)
 - ▶ Comparison of Source and Binary packages
 - ▶ Packages can be ignored
- buildd
 - ▶ Selects package from wanna-build to build
 - ▶ Calls sbuild to build
 - ▶ Sends logs to buildd maintainer
 - ▶ Receives signed dsc and uploads package
- sbuild

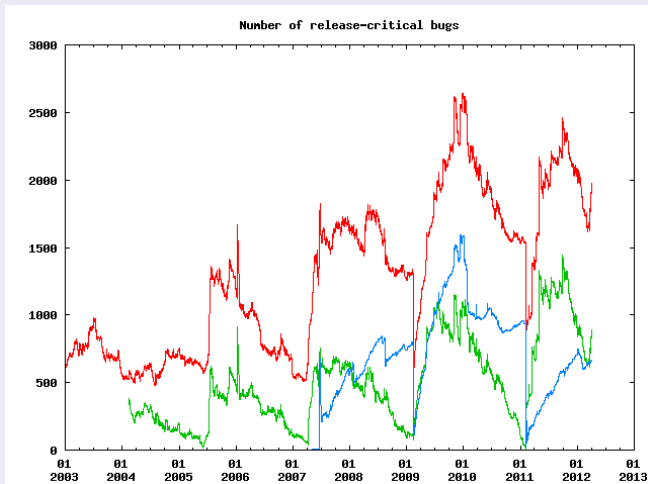

When I run `dpkg-depcheck` on `beagrep`
(<https://github.com/baohaojun/beagrep>) compilation:

```
dpkg-depcheck -b bash -c 'autoreconf -i; ./configure; make -j8'
```

It reports that none of the files used are found in any packages. After a little debugging, I found the `/usr/share/devscripts/Devscripts/Packages.pa` need to be updated because "dpkg -S" output pattern has been updated:
